1. New road construction be minimized.

- 2. Areas to be treated be surveyed botanically for sensitive plant species, and any found be undisturbed. The Priest Lake basin is an especially important area botanically in North Idaho.
- 3. When roads are put in storage, they be monitored for invasive weed invasion until proven clean (we assume that will be a number of years).
- 4. All efforts be made to prevent noxious weeds spreading from treatment activities; treatment and monitoring for weeds subsequently be part of this project.
- 5. Riparian habitat be protected.
